Sol Cinema policy demonstrating safe working practices relating to COVID-19

Sol Cinema is a small cinema performance in a caravan based on putting audiences into a small place to watch a short video (3-5 minutes) .

Our modus operandi will have to change in the face of COVID 19. We will not be able to serve as many people as we usually do.

Box office

To avoid constant direct face to face contact with audience members, our performers will not be opening the box office. Tickets and packaged popcorn will be handed in the open air in the queue.

Entering the Sol Cinema

Only audience members who are happy to be in a bubble will be allowed into the Sol Cinema at any one time. Hand sanitiser will be given to each audience member.

Our performers will not enter the Sol Cinema once audience members are inside.

Leaving Sol Cinema

Government guidelines state 'Regular cleaning plays a vital role in limiting the transmission of COVID-19...paying attention to all surfaces but especially ones that are touched frequently, such as door handles, light switches, work surfaces, remote controls and electronic devices.'

Once an audience leaves, the Sol Cinema will be aired and we will clean the surfaces before the next audience will enter.
